Literature connections: "Mr. Grumpy's Outing"</li> <li><u>Grade 2</u> Landscapes - Learning from VanGogh, Carla Gollembe, and Nature Literature connection: "Starry Night"</li> <li><u>Grades 4 and 5:</u> Landscapes - Learning from Picasso, Hockney, and nature.</li> <li>All grade levels will learn to use a sketchbook and to keep designs in it.</li> </ul>

<u>Library</u>
<b><u>Kindergarten</u></b> is reading Little Red Hen stories and discussing how nice it is to be a "helper" and the rewards it brings.
<b><u>Grade 1</u></b> is comparing tales that have a male hero and another version of the tale with a heroine. Examples: Sleeping Beauty / Sleeping Bobby and Cinderella / Prince Cinder.
<b><u>Grade 2</u></b> is studying the mystery genre – reading and discussing various mystery books.
<b><u>Grade 3</u></b> is enjoying Aesop Fables and learning lessons that these old stories teach us.
<u><b>Grade 4</b></u> is reading books by Mrs. Ogborn's favorite author and illustrator, Chris Van Allsburg.
<b><u>Grade 5</u></b> is reading a few pages during each class from Ken Burns' book – Grover Cleveland Again. It is a great and entertaining introduction to the presidents of our country.
